


Since 2007, our Food for Thought Education Trust nutritionists have been working with schools to educate year 5 and 6 students about the food they eat and drink, how to read food labels and basic budgeting skills.

The nutritionists teach an inquiry-based learning programme, followed by an in-store session at a local PAK'nSAVE, New World or Four Square supermarket. Food for Thought is delivered into schools throughout New Zealand in partnership with the National Heart Foundation. We've made resources available in English, Maori and Samoan.

During 2021 the Food for Thought team partnered with New World to support the promotion of New World Little Garden, and to promote 'Returning to School' healthy lunch options.

Despite the 2021 school year being disrupted by Covid-19, our nutritionists worked with 13,690 students, 168 schools, 504 classes and 728 parents.
