Imported Ginger:	Large, thick, well rounded root tubers.
Overall Visual Appearance:	
Imported Ginger:	Fresh in appearance. Fully developed (mature) and sound. Ginger must be firm clean and dry; Shape must be true to variety. Size to be consistent within box/bag.
Temperature:	
Imported Ginger:	Optimum storage temperature is 10°C - 12°C
